


## WHAT'S GOING ON IN THE LIBRARY?


The last couple of weeks:


- Kindergartners solved a mystery using their five senses.

- 5th grade took a genre personality quiz.


### **Books We Have Enjoyed**


## Native American Heritage Month




PBS also has a <u>Native American Heritage</u> <u>Collection</u> where you can look at Native American art, history, and culture.


















#### Children's Book Week Nov. 4-10
