


WHAT'S GOING ON IN THE LIBRARY?


Read Alouds Used in Library











Book Checkout

- Students in Kindergarten may borrow one book
- Students in 1st grade may borrow up to three books at a time.
- Students in 2nd grade may borrow up to five books at a time.
- Students in grades 3rd-5th may borrow as many books as they are responsible for.

Items are checked out for two weeks at a time and can be renewed for an additional two weeks. Students who finish their books before their scheduled library time are encouraged to come to the library during our open checkout every morning from 8:35-8:50.

- 3. Sign-in using MyAccess.


Sept. 22nd -28th was **Banned Books Week**
