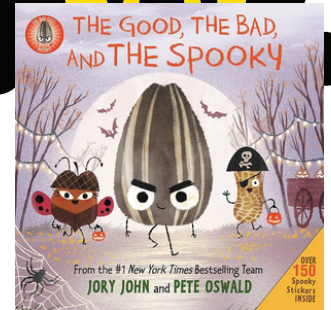
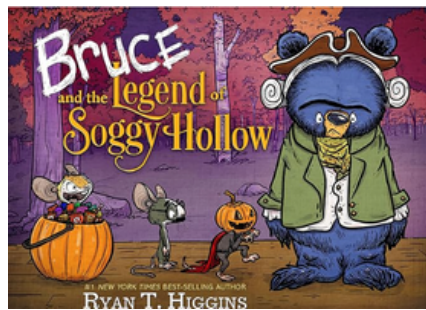


## WHAT'S GOING ON IN THE LIBRARY?

## Book Checkout

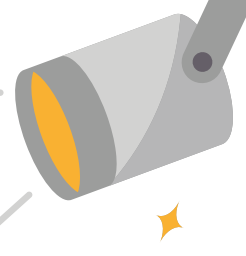
- Students in Kindergarten may borrow one book
- Students in 1st grade may borrow up to three books at a time.
- Students in 2nd grade may borrow up to five books at a time.
- Students in grades 3rd-5th may borrow as many books as they are responsible for.

# Author Spotlight



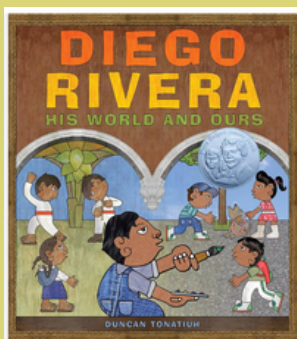
## Kelly Yang
